Though we support missionaries in foreign countries, many of our missionaries are located here in the United States on Indian Reservations across the Midwest.

Dorm

In Dulce, there is a facility for Native American children who are unwanted, abandoned, or orphaned. The Jicarilla Nation takes these children in and provides for them physically and materially. Good News Baptist Church takes these children in and provides for them spiritually. We hold services at the Dorm and include the children in church services and activities as often as possible.



Bus

The bus ministry is a new ministry of the church. Dulce has a large number of children and adults who wish to come to church, but have no way. Good News Baptist Church is providing a way for them to come hear the Gospel at services and participate in activities.

Jail

The jail ministry is one of the oldest ministries of Good News Baptist Church. Men from the church hold services in the local jail twice a week. Several men and women have received Christ through this ministry. Both inmates and jailers have come to look forward to the service times.



Outreach Dinner and Visitation

Once a week, Good News Baptist Church holds an Outreach dinner for the community. This give the community a chance to come see the church, meet our congregation, and get a free meal. The church also does visitation on a weekly basis to prospects, new converts, the elderly, and shut-ins.
